PROGRAMS

STARSkate offers opportunities for skaters to develop figure skating skills in four different areas with the option of being tested to Skate Canada Standards. Skaters must contract one of the Club's Skate Canada Professional Coaches to arrange lessons. Lessons are taught in private, semi-private and group format in four disciplines—Ice Dance, Interpretive, Freeskate and Skills.

Rising STARS - Introduces skaters to the STARSkate program. The program will introduce skaters to jumps, spins, skills and ice dance. Skaters will receive 50 minutes of group lessons with a professional coach on Wednesdays and 30 minutes on Monday. A PA will work with the skaters on Monday for an additional 20 minutes. These group lessons are included in fees. Skaters may choose to work with the PA for 20 minutes on Monday or schedule a private lesson with one of our coaches. Private lesson fees are an extra fee and paid directly to the coach. The Rising STARS program is a two night program.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Skate Membership Fee: To participate in the Skate Canada programs, all skaters must be a member of Skate Canada. The Skate Canada membership fee is \$43.70.

Fundraising Registration fees do not begin to cover the costs of ice rentals to run our programs. Throughout the year different fundraising initiatives may take place and we would kindly request your participation. **Bingo is a major fundraiser.** Individuals working a bingo will receive a \$30 credit to help off-set their skater's fees. Each family must commit to working two or four mandatory bingos (number of bingos required depends on the number of nights the skater is registered). The bingo schedule will be posted on our website.

**If you are opting out of bingo your registration fee will be calculated accordingly.

QSC reserves the right to move skaters from one session to another depending on registration and the skater's abilities.

Guest Skating Fees

QSC member \$20/session, \$10/hour
Non QSC Guest \$30/session, \$20/hour

No refunds will be granted after the second week of classes. Credit notes may be issued for withdrawal from a program due to medical reasons accompanied by a Doctor's Certificate. A 10% administration fee and any registration fees paid by QSC on the skater's behalf will be deducted.

A CHARGE OF \$30.00 WILL BE CHARGED ON ALL NSF OR RETURNED CHEQUES.

The QFSC Board reserves the right to change or alter session format pending registration. Low session numbers may warrant cancellation of that session by the Board.
